- 3. Decision-Making under Risk: risk-averseion, lottery, risk-premium, insurane.
- 4. Coase Theorem: market failure, externalities, property rights.
- 5. Game Theory: extensive-form game, Prisoner's Delimma, Nash equilibrium, dominant strategy.
